### **GOAL**

Participants will **UPDATE** their skills and knowledge regarding the transportation needs of older passengers and passengers with a disability. The curriculum assumes that drivers took the original DRIVE course 3 or more years ago. Please include the date & DRIVE trainer for the original course on the registration form.

## CONTENT

- Driver responsibilities regarding passenger safety, comfort, and well being
- Characteristics of dementia and techniques to minimize problem behaviors.
- Correct wheelchair use
- Two techniques to assist passengers to stand from a sitting position
- Hydraulic lift and wheelchair securement rules and regulations (including power chairs and scooters)
- Techniques to maximize the comfort and safety of each trip despite challenging situations (ie. Conflict between a passenger & a driver, conflict between passengers, conflict in passengers' families, & communication between drivers & supervisors)

The curriculum fulfills transportation quality assurance standards for Older Americans Act services in Ohio and Ohio's PASSPORT Medicaid waiver program.

**NOTE:** Training assumes that participants took the original DRIVE course 3 or more years ago.
