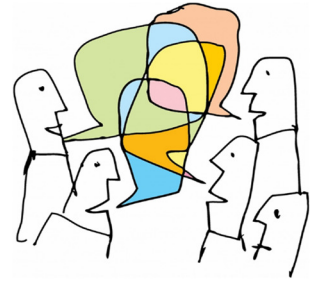

The Role of Diversity in Trauma Treatment: Overcoming Barriers and Empowering Ethnic Identity (Registration limited to 40, please register early!)

Trauma treatment requires culturally compassionate and responsive clinical interventions. Culture, race, ethnicity, gender, and other identities play a significant role in how trauma affects the individual and their treatment. Factors such as mental illness and substance abuse are also critical to the conversation and understanding of intergenerational trauma. The purpose of this workshop is to explore how diversity plays a role in trauma. Participants will receive an overview of intergenerational trauma and the importance of incorporating trauma informed practices and cultural healing in the work we do.

Speaker

Mayte Redcay, LCSW, SAP, CEAP, LCADC is the Executive Director of Serise (www.SeriseInc.com), a university lecturer, an evaluator and a therapist. As the Executive Director of Serise, Mayte has spoken internationally regarding diversity (LGBTQ+, Latinx, communities), trauma, mental health and substance abuse issues. Mayte is a Captain and serves as a Behavioral Health Officer in the New Jersey Army National Guard. As a lecturer, she has taught courses at Rutgers University Center of Alcohol Studies and has previously worked, New Jersey Medical School (NJMS), Rutgers Biomedical and Health Sciences (RBHS,) and Elizabethtown College. Fluent in English and Spanish, Mayte serves as a bilingual evaluator and expert witness, providing forensic psychological services in civil cases and immigration psychological evaluations. She has provided individual, group, family and couples therapy throughout many systems including corrections, intensive outpatient programs (IOP), partial hospital programs (PHP) acute partial hospitalization (APH). Mayte is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW), Substance Abuse Professional (SAP), a Certified Employee Assistant Provider (CEAP), and a Licensed Clinical Alcohol and Drug Counselor.
